What is the programme about?

The programme will focus on the development of practical skills and knowledge in hairdressing. Pupils will combine school with practical training and for one day a week attend Paragon Skills for Industry's Hair Academy to complete a Level 2 Diploma in Woman's Hairdressing. We will also link pupils to a work placement where they will spend up to fifty days over the two years, gaining experience and learning from hairdressing professionals.



Get on Course

The course will consist of mandatory and optional units selected from the following examples:

- Working in Hairdressing
- Maintain salon health and safety
- Client consultation and hairdressing services
- Shampoo and condition the hair and scalp
- Style and dress woman's hair
- Colour hair
- Perm and neutralise hair
- Fulfil salon reception duties
- Display stock to promote sales in a salon

How will the programme be delivered?

You will study for one day every week over a two year period. This time will be divided between theory and practical lessons at Paragon Skills' Hair Academy.

How the qualification is achieved?

The Qualification is achieved through several different forms of assessment. These include:

Observation: Being observed (normally by the course tutor) carrying out practical assignments and activities.

Questioning/testing: Answering relevant questions orally or online, and by writing to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the information.

Assignment and Portfolio work: Compiling a portfolio to include supplementary and supporting material such as - assignments, simulations and photographs.

Where could this programme lead?

On completion you may start your career as an employed hairdressing apprentice, completing your apprenticeship and progressing to advanced apprenticeship. You will have a head start to a fulfilling career. Alternatively you may consider continuing your sixth form to further your academic studies.

Studying outside school

You will be expected to arrive punctually for all sessions, to treat everybody politely and with respect, work hard while in class and dress appropriately. You will not be required to wear school uniform.

What should you do now?

If you are interested in selecting the hairdressing Young Apprenticeship Programme as part of your year 9 options, please see your Head of Year for more information. You will be required to complete an application form. You will also be invited for an interview at Paragon Skills to assess your suitability for inclusion on the programme. You may apply online through the Area Wide Prospectus (AWP).
