A full Level 2 Light Vehicle Maintenance and Repair apprenticeship.

Will I get paid?

Successful applicants can apply to the Government for an Educational Maintenance Allowance (depending on individual circumstances) which provides them with a grant of up to £30 per week for the duration of the course. Paragon Skills can also assist with travel costs.

The opportunities
